#### **Dan Dunmoyer, President & CEO, CBIA**

Dunmoyer's background includes legislative caucus staff leadership and policy committee roles in the California State Assembly, starting as a Fellow in the Jesse Unruh Fellowship program. He served as President and CEO of the Personal Insurance Federation of California from 1996-2005. He served as Deputy Chief of Staff and Cabinet Secretary for Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger from 2006-2008 overseeing all state agencies for the Governor. Most recently he served as Senior Vice President and Head of Government Affairs for Zurich and Farmers Insurance companies. Dunmoyer serves on the Board of Overseers of the RAND Institute for Civil Justice, Chair of the Advisory Committee of the USC Sol Price School of Public Policy, Member of the PPIC Advisory Board on Water Policy and a former Board Member for CalPERS. He is an honors graduate of USC with a bachelor's degree in political science and a master's degree in public administration.
